

Combined Hindi Translators Examination, 2025 (Paper-II) - Information regarding City of examination and Scribe Registration (for 'Own Scribe' candidates).

The candidates of Paper-II of Combined Hindi Translators Examination, 2025 can view their city of examination by logging in through the designated login module on the website of the Commission (<https://ssc.gov.in/>) from today.

2. Candidates availing the 'Own Scribe' facility may require to do fresh Scribe registration on the Commission's website, as the earlier/ existing registration of scribes (prior to 05.11.2025) have been disposed off.
3. The Scribe registration has now been integrated with the Aadhaar Authentication. Therefore, it is mandatory that all such personnel, willing to enrol/ appear as a scribe, may complete their fresh registration on the Commission's website.
4. Candidates who are willing to avail the 'Own Scribe' facility in Paper-II of Combined Hindi Translators Examination, 2025 will be required to submit their Scribe's registration number for generation of their Scribe's Entry Pass. It has been decided by the Commission that for Combined Hindi Translators Examination, 2025, the maximum permissible age limit of personnel appearing in own Scribe will be as per the updated policy (i.e. 22 years). Rest of the guidelines regarding the Scribe facility will remain same as per the notice of the examination.
5. Those candidates who have opted for 'own scribe' will be able to map their Scribe OTR till 10.12.2025(11pm). Scribe pass will be generated only for those candidates who successfully map their Scribe OTR.
6. Admission Certificates and Scribe Entry Pass will be made live about 02/03 days prior to the date of examination (i.e. 14.12.2025). The same may also be downloaded through the designated login module, once made live.
